Day 1

English

Choose a favourite story/ book. Can you retell or reinact the story using figures or cuddly toys? See if you can remember each part of the story!



Phonics

Recap the phonics sounds by watching the videos on the school Facebook page. Can you find any objects around the house with the 'ee' sound? Collect them all up and have a go at spelling the words. Complete Roll and Read below. Roll the dice, whatever number you get read and add sound buttons to a word on that line.

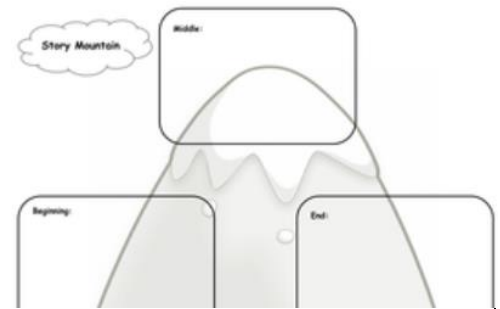
Fine Motor

Remember to try and use capital letters full stops and finger spaces.

Can you recall number bonds to 10?

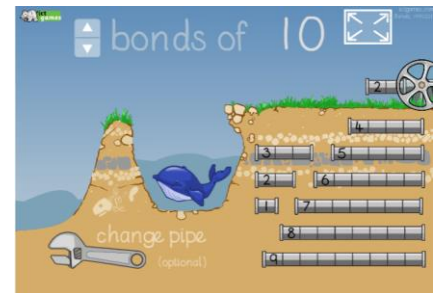

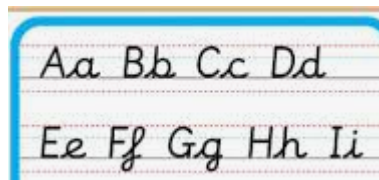
